GETTING TO KNOW YOU. . . .

Q. What is your involvement in church and community?

A. I have served as deacon, Vice Board Chair, Board Chair, and Sunday School teacher in the 60's. I am currently serving as an Elder, a member of the property and personnel committees. I am a Navigator with Opportunity Quad Cities and have worked with them about four years. The group of volunteers help, assist and guide people who are considered poor. I have worked with around 7 individuals so far. I would be glad to talk to church members about this opportunity.

Helen has worked as a deaconess . She also does kitchen help when she can. Helen has helped out with Sunday School from time to time as well. In 2009, when Rev. David Geenen came, Helen approached him about the homelessness of children in the Quad Cities. As a result a committee was formed and the Place 2b was created downtown Rock Island. She also goes on elder calls with me to the hospitals, rest homes and members' homes. We also attend Bible study.

Q. Why do you give of your Time, Talents, and Treasures?

A. I can remember my mother and father spent many hours doing church work on Sundays and through the week. As a younger person I did not understand. As I have grown I realize why they did it. We love God, the church and it's people. We want to show others our belief is real by doing good "Works". Giving our time, talents and money. It not only takes money to run the church but workers too.
