



..... A message from Pastor Mike

We are now in the season of the church year that is called Lent. Some may be unfamiliar with this season, or have forgotten the significance of it. They may ask the question, what is it and why does it matter? The word Lent comes from an old word meaning "Spring" or "lengthen," as in the days are getting longer at this time of the year. Lent was set at forty days using the example of Jesus fasting for 40 days in the wilderness. If you look at the calendar, though, there are 46 days between Ash Wednesday and Easter. That is because the Sundays of Lent aren't counted in the total! Some think that was to highlight the point that whatever had been given up for Lent could be enjoyed on Sabbath days. Others think the Sunday rule was just to help make the nice round figure of 40 days for the Season of Lent.

Historically, Lent was a time of catechism and preparation, leading up to candidates joining the church on Easter morning. We can follow that model by preparing our hearts, through repentance and renewal, as we look ahead to the most holy day of the Church Calendar. There are many different traditions associated with the Season of Lent. Some people give up something for forty days, maybe chocolate or movies or ice cream. Rather than giving something up, some people *add* a spiritual practice to their Lenten schedule. Perhaps morning and evening prayer receive a renewed emphasis. Maybe the adopted practice is to linger prayerfully over a short reading of Scripture. Another person may decide to attend a retreat. There are many options.

Our Ash Wednesday service centered on the message found in the Old Testament book of Joel. A terrible plague of locusts had ravaged the land of Israel. People were starving and full of anxiety about the future. The prophet's recommendation for the people was to return to the Lord. They had been so busy with making a living and with all the normal cares of life that Joel felt it was necessary to challenge them about neglecting their spiritual lives. He knew what he was talking about. In just 73 verses (3 chapters) Joel quoted or referenced at least 20 other prophets. He painted an accurate picture of a very big problem. He wrote, "assemble the congregation for mourning and repentance." And then, right after his call to return to the Lord, he moved right into the promise of hope that God gives to the people of every time and place! Lent may have the reputation of being a season of mourning and sadness, but it points us and prepares us for the greatest hope that we have as Christians, the Resurrection of the Lord on Easter morning!

"Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart... return to the Lord, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love" – Joel 2:12-13 –
