A Message from Pastor Mike—

We will be starting a new Bible Study series during the month of October. Judie will continue to lead our weekly discussions, as we move from the Gospel of Luke to that author's sequel, known as the *Acts of the Apostles*. Once again, our workbook is written by the author Tara-Leigh Cobble. The title of Cobble's study book is *Acts: The Spirit and the Bride - A 10 Week Bible Study on God and His Church*. Those ten weekly studies usually cover three chapters of Acts, but a couple of sessions focus on just two chapters. We may not cover that much ground each week, it will depend on how much discussion is generated within each weekly study.

Back in the first century, they didn't have book-binding yet. Luke's writings were basically one long story, but it was divided into two portions, his gospel and Acts. Experts think the practical length of a scroll was about 35 feet. It was easier to handle, unroll, and re-roll a scroll of that size. Luke's "part 2" describes the spread of the church, way out beyond Jerusalem.

After the resurrection, but before Jesus' ascension into heaven, Luke says in his Gospel that Jesus appeared to the disciples and taught them throughout a 40-day period. Ten days after the Ascension, the Holy Spirit fell on the disciples (and many others) on the Day of Pentecost. The apostles were filled with wisdom and power on that day, and from there the church spread out really fast. All told, the Book of Acts covers about 30 years of activity. John said, in his gospel, that Jesus needed to *physically* leave the scene so that the Holy Spirit could come and empower the church for its mission. That mission was kick-started and super-charged over that first 30-year period!

Acts is often described as a book of history, but it is much more than that. Acts, as you might expect, is full of *action*! In those 28 chapters, we learn about Paul's life and work, about the birth and function of the church, and about the beliefs and activities of Jesus' closest followers. In those pages, we find many speeches. We find a strong defense of the Word of God and of the Christian faith. We find Peter and Paul championing the spread of the good news to Gentiles in many nations and among many people groups. We find practical ways to live out our faith in our everyday lives. The New Testament gives us great guidance on how to be the church together. Everyone is welcome to attend the weekly Bible Study on Thursdays, at 10AM. May God's word abide in you every day, and may God bless you as we move into October and into the beauty of the Fall season.
